Savage Wonder Art Center Awarded \$460,000 by the New York State Council on the Arts to Create New Mainstage Theater in Beacon

Beacon, NY – May 16, 2025 – The Savage Wonder Art Center – The Thomas Poole and Charles Scott Griesa Center Foundation (dba Savage Wonder Art Center) – is proud to announce it has been awarded a \$460,000 grant from the New York State Council on the Arts (NYSCA). This transformational funding will support the development of a professional mainstage theater inside the historic Mechanic Savings Bank on Main Street in downtown Beacon, NY.

The 100-year-old building will be reimagined as a fully equipped theater and arts venue dedicated to performances that amplify the voices of military veterans and their families. This project underscores Savage Wonder's mission to provide a space in which to spotlight the creative talents of veterans and elevate their stories through outstanding theater, art, music and a range of multi-disciplinary performances.

"Our arts and culture sector is a powerhouse, inspiring the world with innovation and creativity," Governor Hochul said. "By investing in our museums, our theaters and our arts centers, we enrich our communities, strengthen local economies and improve tourism all over the State."

NYSCA Executive Director Erika Mallin added, "These transformative projects improve communities, drive tourism and foster innovation in the field. This investment is part of a broader initiative by NYSCA to support cultural organizations across the state. In FY 2026 alone, the Council will award more than \$161 million to arts organizations and artists in all 10 state regions.
